BURN BAN RESCINDED FOR TRANSYLVANIA COUNTY OPEN BURNING IS ALLOWED

Effective at 5pm. Wednesday, November 22nd, 2023 the NC Department of Agriculture and the Transylvania County Fire Marshal's Office has rescinded / lifted the Burn Ban that was placed in effect on 11/06/2023. Open burning is allowed and includes burning leaves, branches, vegetation materials, recreational campfires, bonfires, and outdoor fireplaces.

Any open burning must be constantly monitored and never left unattended. In all cases, it is illegal to burn trash, lumber, tires, plastics, and non-vegetative materials.
