FIX Transylvania County Schools

Projects already funded from the Recommendations to Date since March presentation:

- Air Quality: Testing was initiated by commissioners and funded in Dec 2023/Jan 2024. Recommended cleaning was complete in May 2024 and commissioners allocated funds for the recommended moldy ceiling tile replacements in June 2024, \$200,000
- HVAC Boiler purchases identified as urgent for winter 2024-2025 by TCS were funded for BMS, PFE and RHS in the total of \$577,064.
- Athletic Facilities: Commissioners approved athletic projects in the recommendations that can move forward without being under the larger bond projects. Board of Education will determine alternatives implemented within those project budgets totaling \$4.3 million including:

□BES Playground: \$300,000

□BHS Pre-engineered building for wrestling: \$1.2 million

□RES Plauaround: \$500.000

□RMS/RHS Football Field: \$2.1 million

□TC Henderson Pedestrian Bridge and Playground: \$203,500

 Remaining needs are being scoped into project packages with timelines from 2024 forward. Details to come in July!
