### **MINUTES**

#### CALL TO ORDER

- I. WELCOME: Ms. Katherine Buzby called the meeting to order at 4:05PM. Mr. John Koury joined the meeting a few minutes later and took over as Chair. Ms. Chelsea Preciado, Mr. Billy Parrish, Ms. Nikki Ransdell, Mr. William Hunter, Ms. Nicole Bentley, and Ms. Geri Connell were present. Mr. Sam Hayes was absent (excused). A quorum was present. Ms. Ashley Minery from the Planning Department was also present.
- II. PUBLIC COMMENT: (15-minute time limit. Speakers are limited to three minutes) There were no public comments.
- III. AGENDA MODIFICATIONS: Ms. Minery informed the commission they were due to hold officer elections at this meeting. A. <u>The Zachary House Application:</u> Ms. Minery provided an update on the Zachary House report. Sam hopes to have a draft for JHPC's review at the next meeting.

B. The Inn at Brevard: Ms. Minery informed the commission the Inn at Brevard was set to be purchased by new owners. The new owners have owned historic properties before and are aware some exterior repairs need to be made to the property to remain in compliance with HPC standards. Staff will try to arrange a meeting when the new owners take possession of the property.

- A. <u>America 250<sup>th</sup> Flower Trail Planning Session:</u> Ms. Pinkie Byrd, from Friends of Silvermont, explained the project concept for the Flower Trial and plans to seek TDA funding for the sign purchase. An electronic map of the sites will also be made available. JHPC members suggested various sites in the county to represent different periods of American history. Ms. Byrd thanked the JHPC for their expertise.
