TRANSYLVANIA COUNTY TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE MINUTES April 15, 2025, 6:00 PM

- I. Welcome: Mr. Scott McCall called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM. Present were Mr. Scott McCall, Mr. Jimmy Whitmire, Mr. James Felty, Mr. Harold Paxton, and Mr. Keith Wilmont. Those not in attendance were Mr. Keith Wilmont, Mr. Ken Frady, and Mr. Rick Lasater were excused. Ms. Vicki Eastland, representative of the Land of Sky RPO, was present. Transylvania County staff present included Ms. Darby Terrell, Planner. Two members of the public were present.
- II. Public Comment: There was no public comment
- III. Agenda Modifications:

There were no agenda modifications. <u>The Chair, Mr. Scott McCall asked for a motion to approve the agenda. Mr. Mac Morrow motioned to approve the agenda, and Mr. Howard Granat seconded.</u> The motion passed unanimously.

IV. Consent Agenda:

A. Minutes (July 9, 2024)

The Chair, Mr. McCall, requested a motion to approve of the changes discussed, which were correcting the year. Mr. Harold Paxton motioned to approve the minutes with changes discussed, seconded by Mr. James Felty. The motion passed unanimously.

V. Old Business:

A. Transylvania County Comprehensive Transportation Plan (CTP):

Ms. Vicki Eastland, Land of Sky RPO representative updated the Committee she has reviewed a draft and sent back corrections and requests for more updated volume and capacity data. She informed the Committee that the next steps where for Final Engineering Review, for the data she requested, and then a draft will be sent to the Committee in the summer. During which they will review and give staff their comments on changes need to be made. The Chair, Mr. McCall asked when this process will start over, Ms. Eastland said it normally is

every five to ten years, but since the last time was around 2007 it shouldn't be too soon for an update.

B. NCDOT Current Projects Update: See Tables in Attachments 1 & 2

Ms. Eastland provided an update on current and upcoming construction projects. She went down the list with her explanation. She reminded me that most of the projects have either been defunded or pushed back due to the budget deficit that NCDOT is experiencing currently. She did note it would not get better since the disaster in the fall.

The Committee asked clarifying questions on certain projects. Most of the answers given by Ms. Eastland were due to the budget constraints and other larger projects in other counties needing to be funded at the regional level for NCDOT. Which means most of our county projects would more than likely not be funded.

C. LOSRPO Updates:

Ms. Eastland updated the committee on Prioritization, which occurs every two-three years. She stated the current wait is on the Board of Transportation to finalize and approve the State Improvement Program (STIP), which is a list of projects for NCDOT for every county and city in the state. Which should be around this summer, ready for the upcoming meeting in July. Ms. Eastland reiterated the effect of Hurricane Helene and the defunding of other County projects which will affect what money is left. Due to most contractors working on Hurricane Helene projects. She encouraged the Committee to focus on intersection projects for the upcoming Prioritization due to the higher possibility of them to be funded than larger corridor projects.

Mr. McCall requested Ms. Eastland give a brief update on the Brevard Downtown Circulation Study for the Committee. Ms. Eastland informed the Committee the purpose of this study is to provide options on how to improve the traversing of downtown for all traffic specifically centering around the unbalanced couplet of Broad Street and Caldwell Street. The contractor is being asked to provide three options based on the data they have collected on what would be the best options. Ms. Eastland informed them there would be a stakeholder group made up of county and city representatives that will oversee this study. Mr. McCall stated the importance of this study and the clear need to make traffic movement quicker and safer due to the continued increase in traffic they will see in the future. Mr. Morrow informed the group the couplet was an idea from 2007 when the bypass was not created to help solve the issue then. He said it was supposed to

be a temporary fix until a better solution is created which matches the timeline of this study perfectly.

D. Transit Ridership: Yearly Numbers for Fixed Route and Demand Response

Ms. Darby Terrell presented charts and an update on the current state of Transportation. She informed the board of plans to change Fixed Route stops and the current survey open for public feedback. Ms. Terrell discussed improvements the department is trying to implement, including increased marketing, changing Fixed Route stops, and other ideas. During the discussion, members asked questions about driver feedback, areas needing service, and popular destinations.

VI. Public Comment: There were no public comments

VII. Committee Members' Comments:

<u>Jimmy Whitmire:</u> Mr. Whitmire asked NCDOT questions on the FEMA debris pickup, due to him seeing a lot of piles left without proper cleanup. He wanted to know when Soil and Water could come to clean up instead. He is concerned that the next high water will wash away the piles. Mr. Whitmire wanted to know who oversees these crews.

Mr. Troy Wilson of NCDOT answered it is out of NCDOT's realm, the crews are not contracted out to NCDOT. Mr. Wilson also directed Mr. Whitmire to the County Manager Jaime Laughter, since she is the contact for FEMA debris pickup for the county. He cautioned Mr. Whitmire there are multiple phases of the debris removal and will take more than six months to a year at least. A discussion continued on this topic.

<u>Harold Paxton:</u> Mr. Paxton shared photos of the FEMA debris pile that Mr. Whitmire talked about. (Attachment 2)

<u>Scott McCall:</u> Mr. McCall mentioned the process for cleanup has stepped up since the visit from Trump. He mentioned the Army Corp of Engineers deadlines have been moved to June and July with some of the cleanup projects.

Mr. Chapman mentioned they had received an update in Asheville that the Army Corp has contracted out to three different contractors to focus on debris removal. Mr. Chapman warned them that Transylvania County will not be a top priority with so many other damaged communities in other counties. Mr. Chapman stated that they did receive a guarantee that the debris pickup will not be put in the County's landfill.

Multiple committee members and Troy Wilson began discussing more on the debris clean up and the processes that are being followed.

Mr. Lasater moved to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Wilmont seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously, and the meeting was adjourned at 7:13 PM.






Demand Response Monthly

Transylvania County Prioritization 8.0 Project Meeting

The list of highway projects we are looking to submit this round are below:

- 1. US 64 Asheville Hwy/Morris Road intersection improvement. (either stand alone or with Us 64 Asheville Hwy/ Ecusta Road)
- 2. US 64/Ecusta Rd either stand alone or with Morris Rd,
- 3. US 64 S. Broad/N Country Club/Rosman Hwy/S Caldwell intersection improvements
- 4. Ecusta Rd either upgrade roadway or modernization which ever scores better
- 5. Crab Creek Rd/Everett Rd intersection improvement
- 6. US 276/Elm Bend intersection improvement Either stand alone or with Park/Neely/Outland Dr/Park View

- 7. US 64 Rosman Hwy Clement Rd to US 178

Once the DRAFT list is approved it will be released for public comment and come back to both the TCC and Board for final recommendation and adoption at the September TCC and Board meetings. Once submitted NCDOT will score the projects, and we will go from there with local input.
