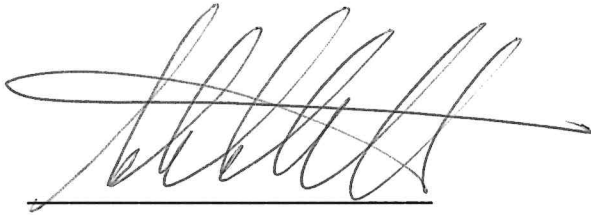
CALL TO ORDER

- I. **WELCOME:** Chairman Rick Lasater called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM. Ms. Wendy Warwick and Mr. Bramley Fisher were also present. Mr. Herschel Johnson, Mr. Greg Cochran, Mr. Mike Privette, and Mr. Jeremiah McCall were absent (excused). A quorum was not present. Ms. Ashley Minery of the Transylvania County Planning Department was also present.
- II. **PUBLIC COMMENT** (15-minute time limit. Speakers are limited to three minutes.)
There were no public comments.
- III. **AGENDA MODIFICATIONS:**
There were no proposed agenda modifications.
- IV. **CONSENT AGENDA**
 - A. Meeting Minutes (May 14, 2026)
Because a quorum was not present, the consent agenda was continued to the next meeting.
- V. **OLD BUSINESS**
 - A. Community Survey Update
Ms. Minery informed the board that the Community Survey was active now. Hard copies are available in the Planning Department if anyone doesn't want to take it online. It has been promoted on social media, high traffic community places, and on white squirrel radio. It will remain active throughout the first week of July. Ms. Minery will present the survey results to the board at the July meeting.
- VI. **STAFF UPDATES**
 - A. Comprehensive Transportation Plan Approval
Ms. Minery presented hard copies of the Comprehensive Transportation Plan (CTP) to the board. This was for informational purposes only, as the draft has already been approved by the Transportation Advisory Committee, who served as the steering committee for this plan. The CTP is currently being reviewed and adopted by the Town of Rosman and the City of Brevard. After it is approved by the municipalities, it will be presented to the Board of Commissioners.
 - B. Transit Study and Staffing
Ms. Minery updated the board on the ongoing Transit Study. The study will evaluate funding uses, existing routes and ridership, staff responsibilities, and fleet inventory. The study will result in recommendations to improve efficiency and service.
