Here is a checklist for you to review and prepare for prior to a fire inspection. Please note: These items listed are many of the items that will be covered during the fire inspection. Some occupancies have different requirements based on operations and are referenced in the NC Fire Code.

MISCELLANEOUS – Verify Street numbers are posed address side and are visible from the road. Verify gas meters are protected from vehicle impact. Verify storage from ceilings are maintained, 18 to 24 inch clearance. If in the City of Brevard, confirm Knox Box with access keys with Brevard Fire Department. Verify your smoke and carbon monoxide detector/alarms are working if required.
