


TRANSYLVANIA COUNTY EMS (TCEMS) SUMMARY OF RESPONSES 2017

TOTAL CALLS TO EMS

TCEMS saw a 2.4% increase in total call volume from 2016 to 2017.

There was a larger increase in call volume (5.05%) to outlying areas, where response time and transport times are significantly greater.



Total call volume has increased nearly 60% in the past 15 years (2017 compared to 2002), and has more than doubled over the past 20 years (2017 compared to 1997).

CALLS BY MONTH, DAY, AND TIME


EMS calls are distributed fairly evenly through the week, with slightly more calls on Mondays.

Calls are more frequent from mid-day to early evening, with the most common time at 12:00-12:59 and the least common time at 04:00-04:59.

Slightly more calls are received in January, June, and July than other months.


RESPONSE TIMES

Average response time and average transport time both increased slightly in 2017 compared to 2016.

Average response time within Transylvania County is 1.9 minutes longer than the national average; transport time is 3 minutes longer.

One reason for increasing response and travel times is an increase in the percentage of calls from outlying areas of the county.





Response and transport times have increased, both short-term and long-term. In 2007, average response and transport times were very close to the national average.




RESPONSE TIMES BY LOCATION

In 2017, the average response time in the Brevard district was 7 minutes, less than the national average.

However, response times to outlying districts are much longer, ranging from 11 minutes to 25 minutes.

Average Response Time by District






NUMBER AND TYPE OF RESPONSES

TCEMS responded to 5131 calls in 2017, up from 5008 in 2016.

On average, TCEMS responds to a call every 1 hour and 42 minutes.



Compared to 2016, transports increased 0.29% and no transports increased 5.4% in 2017.

RESPONSES BY LOCATION

Cedar Mountain and Pisgah National Forest Fire Districts had lower percentages of transports, while North Transylvania Fire District had a higher percentage of transports, compared to other districts.

Most of the standby responses occurred in the Brevard Fire District.



OUT-OF-COUNTY TRANSPORTS

There were 310 out-of-county transports in 2017.

TCEMS is working with Mission on strategies and protocols to reduce out-of-county transports, and has already seen a 26% decrease compared to 2016.

Nearly a third of out-of-county transports (91 calls) occurred between 2100 and 0900, when TCEMS is limited to two on-duty ambulances.





BACKUP SUPPORT

Transylvania County Rescue Squad (TCRS) provided an additional transport ambulance 81 times in 2017, providing:

- 31 transports to TRH
- 1 transport to residence
- 37 no transports
- 6 standby response for fire or law enforcement
- 1 standby for public service

All TCRS transports provided basic life support.



The most common day for backup response was Monday; the most common times for backup support were 21:00-22:59, when EMS has only 2 ambulances on duty..



The vast majority of transport destinations is Transylvania Regional Hospital.


Other hospitals (Mission, Pardee, and Park Ridge, all of which are outside the county) account for almost 10% of transports and increase the average transport time.

Only about 6% were children.




TYPE OF CARE PROVIDED

About two-thirds of all transports required advanced life support in 2017, a slight increase compared to previous years.

About half of transports were medical calls.

The number of trauma and DOA transports increased slightly in 2017 compared to previous years.
