PROTECT Transylvania Natural Resources

Clean water, sanitary sewer, solid waste disposal and restore streambanks

- *Upper Transylvania Engineering Study for Rosman Burlingame System
- *Water System Interconnection for Town of Rosman and City of Brevard for emergencies. Expected award 10/28
- *New Landfill Cell to extend the life of the County Landfill Construction to complete by July 2025. Rebidding (bid date during storm)
- ***Emergency Water Protection Streambank Restoration- almost complete**
- Requesting infrastructure planning docs from Brevard and Rosman

PROTECT- Focus on Infrastructure

- > Grant Funds are for water/sewer/stormwater require that projects submitted to be completed, but will allow partial funding if other funding is secured and can meet spend deadline for completion
- > County does not provide water and sewer so does not receive revenue from new customers due to these projects. Town and City benefit directly from new customer revenue.
- > County benefits with housing and economic development opportunities
