### Third Party Inspection

(General Statute 160D-1106)

Pursuant to General Statute 160D-1106 a design professional (licensed architect, licensed engineer or a person under the direct supervisory control of the licensed architect or engineer), without responsibility to the Authority Having Jurisdiction; is allowed to inspect a design or other proposal for a component or element in the construction of a building, if all of the following criteria are met:

The submission is completed under valid seal of the licensed architect or licensed engineer.

Field inspection of the installation or completion of a construction component or element of the building is performed by a licensed architect or licensed engineer or a person under the direct supervisory control of the licensed architect or licensed engineer.

The licensed architect or licensed engineer under subdivision (2) of this subsection provides the county with a signed, written document stating the component or element of the building so inspected is in compliance with the North Carolina State Building Code or the North Carolina Residential Code for One-and-Two Family Dwellings.

**Documentation shall be submitted to the Transylvania County Building Permitting and Enforcement Department within 24 hours of the inspection.**
