Lists of Resources by Agency

Sharing House (open M-F 9-4)

- 1) Tell flood victim to call Sharing House at 884-2866 and identify themselves as victim of flood.
- If financial assistance is needed, they will talk with Jackie or Susan, crisis managers.
- 3) Food orders are taken over the phone and neighbors pick up food/groceries from the side door at appointed time.
- 4) Produce available anytime by driving to second door in alleyway, ring bell.
- 5) For showers, laundry, school supplies, diapers, tampons, sanitary pads, blankets/pillows, trash bags, etc. just have neighbor come to SH and ring the front door bell.
